Monday, July 22, 2019, at 7:30 p.m. at Gary City Hall

The Gary City Council met in a special session on Monday, July 22, 2019, at 7:30 p.m. in the City Hall. Aldermen Albert Bekaert, Joni Kjelden, John Jenson, David Peterson, Clark Dessler, and Darwyn Engesser, were present. Mayor Jeff Engesser presided. Present also was Shirley Pederson.

Motion by Darwyn Engesser, second by Bekaert to approve the agenda. All members voted aye, motion carried.

Motion by Darwyn Engesser, second by Jenson to plan a special event for the bike riders that are part of DAMn (Day Across Minnesota) uptown on August 2, 2019. Approximately 300 riders will arrive in Gary earlier that week to prepare for their 240 mile bike ride across Minnesota. They will leave Gary at midnight on August 2nd and arrive at their destination in Wisconsin by midnight on August 3rd. The Gary liquor store and The Alibi will provide live music and a beer garden on the sidewalk between the Alibi and the liquor store on the evening of August 2nd from 7-10 p.m. All members voted aye, motion carried.

Motion by Bekaert, second by Jenson to issue temporary beer/liquor licenses to the Alibi and the liquor store to have beer gardens on the sidewalk in front of their businesses on August 2 & 3 (until 1:00 a.m.), 2019. All members voted aye, motion carried.

First reading of Ordinance #366 – 2019 Supplemental Appropriation Ordinance for liquor store remodel was heard.

Motion by Darwyn Engesser, second by Bekaert to adjourn. All members voted aye, motion carried.
