The Gary City Council met in a special session on Tuesday, March 24, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. in the City Hall. Aldermen Albert Bekaert, Joni Kjelden, John Jenson, Clark Dessler, and Darwyn Engesser, were present. Absent was David Peterson. Mayor Jeff Engesser presided. Present also were Robin Lanners, Mike Nosbush, and Shirley Pederson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the COVID-19 Virus and for the council to take necessary action. Motion by Bekaert, second by Jenson to approve and adopt Resolution 2020-02 which addresses the action taken by the city council. Basically all non-essential businesses will be closed to the public except by appointment only. Eating establishments will be take-out or delivery. The City Office along with the City Library will be by appointment only. The municipal liquor store will go to off-sale only. Their hours will be from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. These hours will be re-evaluated at the April 6<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. A roll call vote was taken: Bekaert, aye; Kjelden, aye; Jenson, aye; Dessler, aye; Darwyn Engesser, aye; Peterson, absent. Motion carried.
