The property she is looking at now does not belong to the city so she will need to contact the property owner for approval.

Gary Community Club member Tammy Odette was present to get the council's opinion about July 3rd activities. The council had mixed feelings, but ultimately left it up to the community club.

Tammy mentioned that even if they didn't have anything else, they would still like to have the fireworks' display. The council was in favor of that.
