

Gate City Development Association Meeting May 15, 2008

The Gate City Development Association Board of Directors met on May 15, 2008 at the Fire Hall Meeting Room.

Lynda Roll called the meeting to order. Mary read the minutes of the April 17 meeting. Motion Roger, second Angel to approve minutes as read. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Angel distributed financial reports including a Profit/Loss statement and a Balance Sheet. Motion Mary, second Roger to accept the financial reports as presented.

The sign at the 3-mile corner was discussed, hoping to add "Gas, Food, Lodging" to the bottom of it. The area is 16 feet wide and 16 inches high. Lynda is to contact Randy Meyer about painting this addition onto the sign and possibly repainting other portions of it.

The train signs. Catholic Church will return a portion of property to the city for placement of the sign on the south side of town. Need to confirm contact with Thorpes regarding other location near fire hall. Lynda to check into solar flood lights.

The housing project is on hold. Too many irons in the fire right now.

Discussed locating trails on section line public road right of ways. Mary to contact Wayne Haug about whether or not the state line would be included in this public use area.

It was decided that a recycling project is not feasible at this time.

Angel moved, seconded by Mary to adjourn. Next meeting June 19, 7 p.m.
