


Gate City Development Association met for a special meeting on Monday, **June 10, 2013** at Prairie View Club House with the following members present: Patti Haas, Marion Denekamp, Will Stone, Mary Nosbush, Brad Stevens and Angel Oeltjenbruns. Absent: Stuart Almos. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Stone at 9:45 p.m.

Angel explained to the group that we have two options to proceed on our grant application for the land development project. The original application was for \$130,000 through USDA Rural Development. Darlene Bresson from their office in Watertown has contacted us that we can immediately qualify for a \$38,000 guaranteed grant on an immediate basis from funds now in reserve; or we can continue with our application, as prepared, and wait until September notification, with no guarantee of funding.

Motion by Patti Haas, second by Marion Denekamp to accept the \$38,000 R-BEG grant offer and drop our original grant application of \$130,000. All present voting yes, motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:20 p.m.





Gate City Development Association met for a special meeting on Monday, **July 1, 2013** with the following members present: Patti Haas, Marion Denekamp, Will Stone, Mary Nosbush and Angel Oeltjenbruns. Absent: Stuart Almos, Brad Stevens.

Chairman Stone called the meeting to order at 8:30 p.m. He reported that he had just come from the Gary City Council meeting. The Council agreed to bring the sewer line as far as a manhole at the north end of Grand <sup>Bldg</sup> Avenue, to assist in our infrastructure project. They will need to adopt a special budget ordinance with a first reading at their August meeting and final adoption at their September meeting.

Completion of Grand Boulevard is planned for July, with sewer design and installation to follow as soon as possible. Angel offered to contact attorney to set up a purchase agreement on Lot 1, Block 3 of the Gate City Development Addition to the City of Gary, Deuel County, South Dakota, with ~~Dyno-Tech~~ <sup>Tim Lundquist</sup> Industries. Will is to meet with Deuel County Commissioners Tuesday, July 2 regarding progress on the development of the industrial park.

The meeting was adjourned by Chairman Stone.
